Appearance

1. Sixth form students are required to wear smart business dress; suit, shirt and tie for boys, collared shirt and jacket with skirt or trousers for girls. No jeans or corduroy trousers.
2. Jewellery and make-up of any kind, including ear-rings, is not permitted in years 7-11
3. A slight covering of make-up is permitted for girls in years 10 and 11 experiencing skin problems with the permission of her Head of House.
4. Hair below collar length (male or female) should be tied back and long fringes are to be clipped back away from the eyes. Hair bands and clips, including Alice bands, must be navy blue
5. Boys top buttons should be done up with a tie, blazers worn and dark blue coat (not leather, vinyl or bomber jacket) worn over the blazer (not as a replacement) in winter
6. Hoodies and other jackets/sweatshirts are not allowed
7. Girls shoes should have a square heel (max heel height 4cm), lace up, Velcro or mid foot strap. Kitten heels, court shoes, pumps and other fashion shoes are not acceptable. Leather, polishable shoes are advised for boys and girls
8. Trainer socks are not permitted
9. Boarders additional belongings required are listed in the house handbook
10. All students should dress so as not to cause distraction to others and must be in accord with health and safety requirements
11. Incident slips are given to pupils who do not adhere to school uniform regulations which start a procedure of sanctions which could result in being sent home by the Head Teacher
12. All uniform must be clearly labelled with sewn in name tapes
